Related Information

This policy was originally numbered as 7-106 from its adoption in 1988 until 6/12/1992 when it was renumbered to 7-107. In January 1999, it was renumbered to 7-110. Finally, it became 7-111 in September 2001.

7-111 has been the number assigned to multiple policies since the Policy Manual was adopted in 1983. It was originally assigned to the Contracts with Architects policy. Article A of Chapter VII was revised in January 1988 and 7-111 was repealed. In June 1992, Chapter VII was revised again and 7-111 was assigned to the Space Management policy. Upon another revision in January 1999, 7-111 became the Capital Project Status Reports policy. Chapter VII was again revised in September 2001 and 7-111 was assigned to the Project Closeout Phase policy. That policy was renamed to Project Closeout in June 2005 and was repealed in June 2022.
