

CHARTER

LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE Of the Arizona Board of Regents

A. Purpose

To assist the board in fulfilling its oversight and monitoring responsibilities for the university system's government affairs activities.

B. Organization

The Legislative Affairs Committee is a standing committee of the board. Each year the incoming board chair will appoint members to and designate the chair of the Legislative Affairs Committee.

C. Meetings

The Legislative Affairs Committee shall schedule meetings taking into consideration the board's regular meeting schedule and legislative timelines. The Legislative Affairs Committee may hold additional meetings as circumstances require.

D. Authority and Responsibilities

The authority and responsibilities of the Legislative Affairs Committee will include the following:

- 1. As directed by the board, taking positions on state and federal legislation and providing direction on related issues to the system's government affairs professionals.
- 2. Guiding and monitoring government relations activities.
- 3. Facilitating appropriate collaboration in government relations activities in support of ABOR's mission and goals.
