



Collision Information Exchange Checklist

Print and carry this form in your motor vehicle.

Drivers involved in a collision resulting in any of the following **MUST** file an Oregon collision report with DMV:

- Injury or death to any person
- Damage over \$2,500 to the vehicle you were driving
- Damage over \$2,500 to property other than a vehicle involved in the collision
- Damage over \$2,500 to any vehicle AND any vehicle is towed from the scene as a result of damage from the collision

Oregon law requires drivers to file an *Oregon Traffic Collision and Insurance Report* within 72 hours of a reportable motor vehicle collision. You can download the report from DMV's website at:

Even if law enforcement files a police report, drivers must report to DMV when a collision results in the reportable criteria above. DMV must suspend your driving privileges if you fail to file a report.
