



Crash Information Exchange Checklist

Print and carry this form in your motor vehicle.

Drivers involved in a crash resulting in any of the following MUST file a *Crash & Insurance Report*:

- Damage to your vehicle is over \$2500
- Injury (No matter how minor)
- Death
- Damage to any one person's property over \$2500
- Any vehicle has damage over \$2500 and any vehicle is towed from the scene as a result of damages

Oregon law requires filing a crash report within 72 hours of a reportable motor vehicle crash.

When a crash meets the criteria that results in the requirement to file a report, even if law enforcement files a report, each driver involved in the crash must file a report. Failure to file a report results in DMV issuing Notice of Suspension.
