111. Chief Executive Officer

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111.1: PURPOSE AND SCOPE

All law enforcement Chief Executive Officers employed within the State of Oregon are required to meet specific requirements for appointment. This policy provides guidelines for the appointment of the Chief Executive Officer of the Albany Police Department, who is required to exercise the powers and duties of the office as prescribed by state law (OAR 259-008-0060).

111.2: POLICY

It is the policy of the Albany Police Department that the Chief of Police meets the minimum standards for exercising their authority granted by law.

111.3: CHIEF OF POLICE REQUIREMENTS

The Chief of Police of this department, as a condition of employment, should have, within two years of appointment, successfully obtained Executive certification through the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) and be licensed as a Peace Officer by DPSST.
