# PURPOSE

To advise all employees of the bait-car deployment, contact, and recovery procedures.

# POLICY

The bait-car program can be used to effectively capture would be vehicle thieves with minimal risk of injury to citizens, officers, or the suspects.

### DISCUSSION

Deployment of the bait-car will be coordinated through the Theft Unit supervisor. Personnel may discuss the bait-car's basic capabilities with the public and may advertise the program as an example of the Department's proactive approach to auto theft, however the bait-car program is considered an undercover operation. Accordingly, all personnel shall exercise caution in order to protect the bait-car's status.
