Section 1: Significant Incidents

Case AR24-010624

On June 27, 2024, at about 7:04 am, Arvada PD officers were dispatched to a business in the Arvada Ridge Marketplace regarding a motor vehicle theft. Officers arrived and learned that a male suspect had entered the business, stole the victim's car keys, then went outside and tried driving away in the victim's vehicle. The suspect was interrupted by the victim's co-worker and fled on foot to the Super Target across the parking lot.

In the Super Target, the suspect changed clothes but was located and apprehended. The suspect was arrested for burglary, motor vehicle theft, and obstructing a peace officer.

Case AR24-010595

On June 26, 2024, at about 3:30 pm, Arvada PD officers arrested a male suspected of distributing fentanyl and methamphetamine to the homeless population and others in the Olde Town area. He was arrested without incident as he walked out of a local business. The suspect was carrying a backpack which contained approximately 200 fentanyl pills, 28 grams of methamphetamine, cash, and other materials associated with the distribution of illegal narcotics. He was also in possession of a realistic BB handgun and a large knife. He was jailed on two counts of possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute, and a special offender offense (within 1000 feet of a school).

On June 24, 2024, at about 3:04 pm, Arvada PD officers were dispatched to the Standley Lake Library located at 8485 Kipling St regarding a hit and run crash. Multiple callers stated that a male who appeared to be very intoxicated or on drugs had struck multiple vehicles, a pole, and ran over a fence in the parking lot. The male fled on Kipling St but callers provided updated location information to dispatchers, and officers located him near W 66 Ave and Iris St. Officers attempted to stop the suspect but he briefly eluded officers and ultimately stopped near the 6700 block of Kline St. The suspect was arrested for DUI, hit and run, careless driving, eluding, and no proof of insurance.
