To differentiate between services to general campus users and to auxiliary units

Policy

Facilities Management provides services to both general campus users and to <u>auxiliary units</u>. Services to general campus users may be <u>billable</u> or <u>nonbillable</u> (see <u>FAC 202–01</u>, "Billable Services"). Services to auxiliary units are always billable and may be performed on a routine basis or as specially requested jobs and projects.

Auxiliaries

ASU auxiliary units derive a substantial portion of their budgets from revenues generated from providing goods and/or services to the university community and/or the general public. Examples are listed below:

- 1. ASU Bookstore
- 2. ASU Public Events
- 3. Food service contractors or concessionaires
- 4. Intercollegiate Athletics
- 5. Memorial Union and Student Pavilion
- 6. Parking and Transportation Services
- 7. Stadium Management
- 8. Student Development and Residential Life, including fraternities and sororities
