Review and Approval of Activities Involving Live Animals

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) is responsible for reviewing and approving all teaching and research activities involving the use of live animals.

Purchase of Live Animals

Unless approved by the Department of Animal Care Technologies (DACT) and the IACUC, all purchases of live animals must be made through DACT.
