Policy

Under Arizona law, the Arizona Board of Regents (ABOR) is responsible for the control and supervision of the state universities and their properties and activities. ABOR is authorized to enact ordinances for the governance of the universities and the maintenance of public order upon all property under its jurisdiction and has promulgated this *Student Code of Conduct* in order to meet its responsibilities under Arizona law.
