SSM 203-08: Affidavit of Dependency for Release of Records

Purpose

To allow a parent or guardian to request access to a student's academic records

Sources

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (also referred to as the Buckley Amendment or FERPA), 20 United States Code §1232g (1982)

University Registrar Services

Policy

A parent or guardian may request access to a dependent student's academic records by filing an Affidavit of Dependency and a copy of the parent's or guardian's most recent signed IRS 1040 form with the University Registrar Services. Access is subject to the approval of the appropriate office.

Procedure

Responsibility	Action
Parent or guardian	Request access.
University Registrar Services	Supply the instructions required and an Affidavit of Dependency.
Parent or guardian	 Take affidavit to be notarized. Return the notarized affidavit with a copy of the parent or guardian's most recent signed IRS 1040 form to University Registrar Services.
University Registrar Services	 5. Determine that the affidavit and documents are correct and complete. Release requested records if appropriate. 6. File the affidavit for reference for two years and cross-reference it on the Student Information System.
Parent or guardian	7. Renew affidavit every tax year.
