Purpose

To determine aid availability for summer sessions and to set eligibility criteria

Policy

For purposes of awarding summer financial aid, the summer semester is considered a trailer to the previous academic year. Students will be considered for the following aid programs (until such time as funding for these programs is exhausted) on a first-come, first-served basis:

- 1. Federal Pell Grants
- 2. ASU Grants, Student Aid Trust Grants, University Grants
- 3. Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants
- 4. Federal Work-Study
- 5. Federal Perkins Loans
- 6. Federal PLUS Loans
- 7. Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans

8. Tribal Scholarships.
