Student Accessibility and Inclusive Learning Services is the ASU unit that is charged with the responsibility of facilitating access, through the provision of reasonable and appropriate accommodations and services, as defined under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (1990, 2008) and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, for qualified ASU students with disabilities.
