



Career-Track Faculty Appointments and Promotion Committee Charge

Description and Charge

The Career-Track Faculty Appointments and Promotion Committee (CT-FAP) considers all appointments and promotions for career track faculty. The CT-FAP provides its recommendations to the Dean.

Membership

The CT-FAP consists of at least five voting members.

- These members are self-nominated/peer-nominated and peer-selected via the Faculty Council's and Subcommittee on Standing Committees procedures. Members must be at the rank of professor or associate teaching, clinical, or research professor. Only those at or above the rank sought may vote on promotion cases.
- One of the five members is a representative of the Faculty Council. This individual is selected by vote within the Faculty Council.
- The chair is elected from among the current Career-Track FAP members by the members of the Career-Track FAP. They serve a one-year term and may be renewed for an indefinite number of terms.
- The senior administrator(s) designated by the dean to oversee faculty affairs serve in ex-officio support role(s) for the CT-FAP and facilitate communications with the Dean.
- The Career-Track FAP provides its recommendations on faculty to the Dean.

Quorum

A simple majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

A simple majority vote of those present is required for a motion to pass.
