2025-1: Change to the Manual White Blood Cell Differential Test

As of March 10, 2025, changes to the nomenclature for testing under the All Manual WBC Diff Procedures instrument/method will become effective. These changes are necessary to comply with new CLIA regulations requiring proficiency testing for manual and automated white blood cell differentials.

The test, Blood Cell Identification, now must be selected under the instrument/method, All Manual WBC Diff Procedures, to ensure the appropriate test for a manual white blood cell differential is added. For laboratories that currently have All Manual WBC Diff Procedures on their test menus, an update will automatically take place. The test, White Blood Cell Differential (WBC Diff), now must only be used when adding an automated WBC differential test to all other instruments/analyzers.

Below is an example of the previous and new views of the Add Test System screen when adding a manual WBC differential test in COLAcentral.
