Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Performs a variety of sonography procedures utilizing ultrasound equipment according to the manufacturer recommendations and follows established protocols as defined by the radiologist.
 - Enters appropriate patient information and technical factors into the ultrasound unit to image required anatomy.
 - Performs examinations in a manner that optimizes the best visualization of any required anatomy.
 - Identifies each patient, reviews order and previous exam for comparison and appropriateness of orders.
 - Communicates with patient and family, provides instructions and education to obtain desired results, gains cooperation and minimizes anxiety.
 - Carries out requested sonographic procedures using the ultrasound equipment provided.
 - Assesses patient condition and assures patient safety through proper use of restraint/support devices, respects patient ability and comfort.
- 2. Reviews each examination for technical accuracy, correct labeling of images and anatomic orientation, and proper date and patient identification.



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Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Provides quality diagnostic images and accurate history to radiologist and reviews findings with radiologist and/or ordering physician.
- Communicates pertinent data to persons responsible for the care of the patient following the procedure.
- Verifies informed consent for and assists radiologist with interventional procedures utilizing aseptic technique, universal precautions, and transfer of specimens to lab.
- Assists in scheduling patients and procedures to coordinate inpatient, critical or emergency and outpatient schedule efficiently.
- Maintains records, computer/order/resulting/charging entries and filing to maintain patient records and patient confidentiality
- 3. Reviews each examination for technical accuracy, correct labeling of images and anatomic orientation, and proper date and patient identification.
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- 4. Demonstrates exceptional patient communication skills.
 - Assesses patient pain interfering with imaging procedure.
 - Explains the test to the patient in a manner that lowers any anxiety.
 - Introduces self to patient in a cheerful and pleasant manner, follows AIDET principle.
 - Communicates with patient throughout exam to reduce any patient anxiety.
- 5. Maintains supplies and cleanliness in the department.
 - Maintains equipment and recommends service as needed. Carries out necessary quality control and quality assurance to ensure high performance standards are met.
 - Provides ultrasound instruction for students, medical staff, and nursing for the general education of these customers.
 - Assists in Radiology as needed when the ultrasound schedule permits
- 6. Completes various office duties as required.
 - Enters patient data into electronic scheduling systems accurately so as to connect images to PACS.



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Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Schedules exams in coordination with available techs, mobile service and radiologists accordingly.
- Assumes phone responsibilities, when necessary, with proper phone etiquette.
- Ensures patient exams in computer system are accurate to the exam completed.
- Maintains appropriate supply levels throughout the department by ordering, stocking, and checking for outdates.
- 7. Performs and maintains documentation.
 - Thoroughly and accurately completes patient history and associated worksheets for each exam.
- 8. Communicates effectively.
 - Communicates and collaborates effectively with other health team members regarding patient condition and patient satisfactions needs.
 - Identifies and recognizes abnormal symptoms/changes in patient condition, established priorities, and takes appropriate action. Appropriately reports condition changes to medical provider.
- 9. Promotes and ensures patient safety in performance of all responsibilities.
 - Administers treatments and procedures in a timely and safe manner according to physician orders and department policy.
 - Demonstrates proficient technical/clinical skills and operational knowledge of equipment.
 - Informs and involves Radiology Manager regarding patient care issues in a timely and appropriate manner.
 - Utilizes proper body mechanics, transfer/lifting techniques and appropriate equipment to minimize fall risk to patient and injury to self.
- 10. Participates in CRHC'S Quality program, committees, performance and quality improvement initiatives, and activities which support the facility and department operations.
 - Demonstrates a commitment to the practices of Quality Improvement (QI).
 - Regularly attends Department huddles
 - Completes tasks as outlined on Department Huddle Board
- 11. Performs other duties as assigned.
