

# “ — What is... Transitional Care?

Medicare has established coverage for “Swing Bed” programs to serve the needs of small rural hospitals and communities. Transitional Care is what we call our Swing Bed program. Both terms describe a hospital room that can switch from acute care status to skilled care status. The actual bed/room does not change; what changes is the level of care we provide to the patient in our room. Our Transitional Care Program provides skilled nursing care, rehab services, and more.

## Do I qualify for the Transitional Care program?

You must meet the following Medicare requirements to qualify for our program. Our Transitional Care team is available to answer any questions you might have regarding these qualifications:

- 1 **Covered by Medicare Part A\***
- 2 **Have 3 consecutive nights in an acute care bed in the last 30 days**
- 3 **Have a diagnosis that requires skilled care, as defined by Medicare**

*\*Some private insurances cover these services. Contact CRHC or your insurance company for coverage details or questions.*
