- Talk to your family to learn about your family's health history.

ABOUT BREAST CANCER

Breast cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer and is the leading cause of cancer death in women world wide. This type of cancer can be found in both men and women although breast cancer in men is rare. Because of ever improving screening methods and treatments, the risk of death from breast cancer has been decreasing. It's important to stay up-to-date on your mammograms in order to catch it early.

CANCER CARE AT CRHC

Our multi-disciplinary care team is experienced in the treatment of breast cancer and includes an entire team of people, like a Medical Oncologist and radiologists. Physician Assistant. registered mammogram technologists, ultrasonographers, pathologists, and surgeons who work together to provide breast screening services as well as timely diagnosis and treatment of breast abnormalities. Other important team members at CRHC include nurses advanced with training and certification, registered dietitians, and occupational and physical therapists
