

PEDIATRIC WELL VISIT & IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE



CRHC encourages annual well-child visits for children aged 2 to 21 years old. Please visit with your primary healthcare provider if you have questions regarding well child visits or vaccinations.

Newborn	If Hep B was not given in the hospital, it will be given at this visit.	Newborn and Congenital Cardiac Screen, Bilirubin check (if indicated)
2 Week	One (1) dose RSV Monoclonal Antibody < 8 months Given during RSV Season (October - April)	Weight Check
1 Month		Weight Check
2 Month	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Rotarix, Hib	Developmental Screen
4 Month	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Rotarix, Hib	Developmental Screen
6 Month	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Rotarix, Hib	Developmental Screen
7-8 Months	Recommended for 6 months or older: Two (2) doses of Seasonal Influenza Vaccine the first year	
9 Months	Catch up on any missed immunizations	Developmental Screen
12 Month	MMR, Hep A, Prevnar	Developmental Screen, Lead & Hemoglobin Check
15 Month	Hib, DTap, Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Developmental Screen
18 Month	Hep A, Recommended for 1 year & older: Seasonal Influenza Vaccine (Dose dependent on previous vaccinations given)	Developmental & Autism Screen
2 Year	Catch up on any missed immunizations	Developmental & Autism Screen, Lead Level Check (Before age 2)
3 Year	Catch up on any missed immunizations	Developmental Screen
4-5 Year	Kinrix (Dtap, IPV), Proquad (MMR, Varicella)	Developmental Screen, Lead & Hemoglobin Check (if not completed yet)
11-12 Years	Tdap (State requirement before 7th grade), Menveo (Meningitis), Gardasil series (HPV), Optional	Sports Physical, High risk behavioral, Depression/Anxiety Screen
13-14 Years	Completion of Gardasil series (HPV), Optional	Sports Physical, High risk behavioral, Depression/Anxiety Screen
16-18 Years	Menveo (Meningitis) State requirement before 12th grade), Meningococcal B, & Completion of Gardasil series (HPV), Optional	Sports Physical, High risk behavioral, Depression/Anxiety Screen
