CRHC encourages annual well-child checks for ages 2-21 years. Please visit with your provider about any questions regarding well child visits or vaccinations.

<b>2 Week</b>		Weight Check (If indicated)
<b>1 Month</b>		Weight Check (If indicated)
<b>2 Month</b>	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Rotarix, Hib	Developmental Screen
<b>4 Month</b>	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Rotarix, Hib	Developmental Screen
<b>6 Month</b>	Pediarix (DTap, IPV, Hep B), Prevnar, Hib	Developmental Screen
<b>6 Months &amp; older</b>	Any child 6 months or older is recommended an annual influenza shot	
<b>9 Month</b>	Catch up on any missed immunizations	Developmental Screen
<b>12 Month</b>	MMR, Hep A, Prevnar	Developmental Screen
<b>15 Month</b>	Hib, DTap, Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Developmental Screen
<b>18 Month</b>	Hep A	Developmental & Autism Screen
<b>2 Year</b>	Lead Level (Before age 2)	Developmental & Autism Screen
<b>3 Year</b>	Catch up on any missed immunizations	Developmental Screen
<b>4-5 Years</b>	Kinrix (Dtap, IPV), Proquad (MMR, Varicella)	Developmental Screen
<b>11-12 Years</b>	Tdap (State requirement prior to 7th grade), Menactra (Meningitis), Gardasil series (HPV)	High risk behavioral & depression screen
<b>13-14 Years</b>	Completion of Gardasil series (HPV)	High risk behavioral & depression screen
<b>16-18 Years</b>	Menactra (Meningitis - State requirement prior to 12th grade), Meningococcal B	High risk behavioral & depression screen.
