



## ERPO Risk Assessment:

A deputy may petition for an Extreme Risk Protection order if he or she reasonably believes a person poses a significant risk of causing personal injury to self or others by having in his or her custody or control a firearm or by purchasing, possessing, or receiving a firearm, **after consultation with a supervisor.**

This risk assessment should be used as a tool to gather additional information to assist you with determining whether a Law Enforcement Agency (LEA) should seek an ERPO.
