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ORDINANCE NO. 41 - 1993
AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO PARKING
ON CERTAIN STREETS DURING AND AFTER
SNOW STORMS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE TOWN OF DOVER, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE
OF NEW JERSEY

1. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street, all vehicles shall only park on the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule A attached hereto as follows: after 8:00 A.M. on days ending with an even number all vehicles may only park on that side of the street where the building numbers end with an even number; after 8:00 A.M. on days ending with an odd number all vehicles may only park on that side of the street where the building numbers end with an odd number.
2. a. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street, all vehicles shall only park after 8:00 A.M. on the right side of the street facing downhill, on the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule B attached hereto.
b. Commencing at 8:00 A.M. on the day after parking has been restricted in accordance with section 2.a., all vehicles shall only park on the opposite side of the street for that day only. Regular parking will resume at 8:00 A.M. on the next day.
3. The foregoing parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
4. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any peace officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. Before regaining possession of the vehicle, the owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal.
5. The effectiveness of this Ordinance is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.

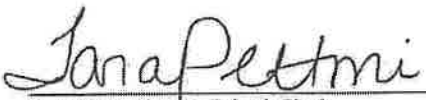
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN
OF DOVER PERTAINING TO PARKING ON MONMOUTH AVENUE
DURING AND AFTER SNOW STORMS**

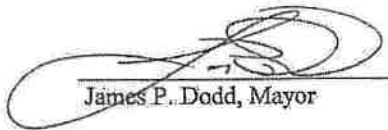
Be it ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover, Morris County, New Jersey as follows:

1. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street, there shall be no parking on Monmouth Avenue in its' entirety.
2. The foregoing parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the street has been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
3. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any peace officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. Before regaining possession of the vehicle, the owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal.
4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this within ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
6. The effectiveness of this ordinance is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.
7. The Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.

ORDINANCE NO. 28-2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DOVER, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ARTICLE XXVIII OF THE REVISED GENERAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF DOVER ENTITLED "PARKING", CHAPTER G "PROHIBITED PARKING"

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.40:48-2*, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal, and enforce such other ordinances, regulations, rules and by-laws not contrary to the laws of this State or of the United States, as it may deem necessary and proper for the good government, order and protection of person and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by this subtitle, or by any law; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Board of Alderman that the current parking restrictions on Summer Avenue should be amended to promote public safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover, County of Morris and State of New Jersey that Article XXVIII of the Revised General Code of the Town of Dover entitled "Parking, Chapter G, entitled "Prohibited Parking" is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. The current restrictions prohibiting parking on Summer Avenue is hereby stricken from the Code. Ordinance 05-1995 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Article XXVII entitled "Parking", Chapter G, entitled "Prohibited Parking" is here by amended and supplement to include:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDES</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Summer Avenue	Both	Entire Length

- A. Beginning at 8:00 a.m. on even numbered days until 8:00 a.m. the following day, parking shall be permitted on the north side of Summer Avenue (even numbered homes) beginning at the intersection of South Morris Street to its terminus. Parking is not permitted on the south side of Summer Avenue (odd numbered homes) on these days.
- B. Beginning at 8:00 a.m. on odd numbered days until 8:00 a.m. the following day, parking shall be permitted on the south side of Summer Avenue (odd numbered homes) beginning at the intersection of South Morris Street to its terminus. Parking is not permitted on the north side of Summer Avenue (even numbered homes) on these days.

SECTION 3. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street, an emergency shall exist and no vehicle shall be parked on Summer Avenue. The above parking prohibition shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased, until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

SECTION 4. The effectiveness of this Ordinance is contingent on signs being erected as required by law.

SECTION 5. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation or provision of this ordinance or any supplement thereto should be liable to a penalty of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisoned for a term not exceeding 15 days or both.

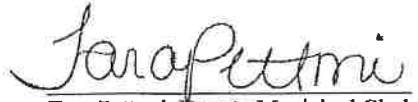
SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 7. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 8. The Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
