eciproc y of concealed handgun permi s s for raveling or visi ing only. A Colorado resident canno legally carry concealed in-s a e using a non-residen permit issued by any o her s a e.

#### **STATUTE 18-12-213**

Colorado will recognize a valid permit to carry a concealed handgun that was issued in a reciprocal state if the permit was issued to a resident of the state that issued the permit. The permit holder must have a valid driver's license or identification card issued from the same state that issued the permit. The permit holder must be 21 years of age or older. When you become a resident of the state of Colorado, you must apply for a Colorado Concealed Handgun ermit. Your valid permit issued from a reciprocal state will only be recognized for 9 days after the date your valid Colorado driver's license or identification card was issued.

# I am moving, wha do I do?

The Change of Address/Lost ermit/Name Change form can be located at epcsheriffsoffice.com. If you move OUT of the state of Colorado and become a resident of another state, your Colorado permit will no longer be valid.

Within 30 days after a permittee changes the address specified on his or her permit, the permittee shall notify the issuing Sheriff of the change of address.

# **COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

Yes, per S a u e 18-12-204: The handgun (pistol or revolver) can be anywhere in your vehicle and does not have to be visible.

# What about dr ving in Colorado?

**Yes, per S a u e 18-12-105.6:** You may travel with a handgun in your private vehicle while in Colorado counties, cities, and municipalities.

#### **STATUTE 33-6-125**

"It is unlawful for any person except a person authorized by law or by the division, to possess or have under the person's control any firearm, other than a **pis ol or revolver**, in or on any motor vehicle unless the chamber of the firearm is unloaded."

If con ac ed by law enforcemen, do I need o no fy he officer hat I have a permit and in possession of a handgun?

No, per S a u e 18-12-204(2)(a): You must carry your permit along with valid photo ID at all times when in possession of a concealed handgun and produce both documents upon demand of a law enforcement officer.

# STATUTE 18-12-214 (1) (b)

"A peace officer may temporarily disarm a permittee incident to a lawful stop of the permittee. The peace officer shall return the handgun to the permittee prior to discharging the permittee from the scene."

Am I eligible for a permi f I use medical or recrea ional marijuana?

No, per S a u e 18-12-203(1)(f): The Sheriff cannot issue a permit to any applicant who is an unlawful user of or addicted to a controlled substance.

#### **STATUTE 18-18-105 (5)**

"Controlled substance means a drug substance, or immediate precursor included in schedules 1 through V of part 2 of this article, including cocaine, marijuana marijuana concentrate cathinones any synthetic cannabinoid, and salvia divinorum."

#### P OHIBITED CONCEALED CA Y LOCATIONS

#### **STATUTE 18-12-214**

- (2) Anywhere prohibited by federal law.
- (3) ...real property, or into any improvements erected thereon, of a public elementary, middle, junior high, or high school.
- (4) ...a public building at which
  - (a) Security personnel and electronic weapons screening devices are permanently in place at each entrance to the building;
  - **(b)** Security personnel electronically screen each person who enters the building to determine whether the person is carrying a weapon of any kind; and
  - **(c)** Security personnel require each person who is carrying a weapon of any kind to leave the weapon in possession of security personnel while the person is in the building.

C y Parks: Yes, with a permit

# S ate Parks:

Yes, in designated areas. CSP Regulation Article IV 1 6(a)(1)

#### Na ional Parks:

Yes, must comply with State/Federal Regulations 16 USC 1a-7b

#### Na ional Fores:

Yes, must comply with State/Federal Regulations 36 CFR 261.10(d)

# SECU E FI EA M STORAGE IN AN UNATTENDED VEHICLE

A person shall not knowingly leave a handgun in an unattended vehicle unless the handgun is in a locked hard-sided container that is placed out of plain view including a locked container that is permanently affixed to the vehicle's interior. (For this section, a locked glove compartment or the locked center console of a vehicle is a locked hard-sided container.)

**No, per S a u e 18-12-204:** Carrying a weapon on your person on public school grounds is a felony in the state of Colorado.

# STATUTE 18-12-214 (3) (a)

"A permittee may have a handgun on the real property of the public school so long as the handgun remains in her/her vehicle and if the permittee is not in the vehicle the handgun is in a compartment within the vehicle and the vehicle is locked."

# What about pr va e colleges or universi ies?

**Per S a u e 18-12-105.5:** If you wish to carry on a private campus review their policies regarding firearms. Consult legal counsel with any specific questions.

Can I carry concealed in a res auran, bar, or o her priva e business es ablishmen?

**Yes, per S a u e 18-12-214:** However a person may not carry where a private property owner tenant employer, or business entity prohibits weapons.

# **STATUTE 18-12-106 (1) (d)**

"A person commits a class 2 misdemeanor if:

(d) The person has in his or her possession a firearm while the person is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or of a controlled substance."

Wha f here s a "No D splay of Firearms" sign on a business or public building?

**Yes:** You may carry a concealed handgun unless other prohibitions apply.

Am I required o have my permit and my Colorado Dr vers License/ID while carrying concealed?

Yes, per S a u e 18-12-204(a): You must carry the permit, together with the valid photo ID at all times when in possession of a concealed handgun.
