## Georgia Department of Corrections Participating Countries Notice

The United States has entered into international treaties with many countries which may permit a foreign national prisoner from one of the treaty countries to transfer to his home country to serve the remainder of his sentence. The State of Georgia has enacted legislation which allows it to participate in the international prisoner transfer program. The transfer program is discretionary and not everyone who applies will be qualified or will be approved for transfer. To transfer you application must first be approved by the State of Georgia. The United States and your home country must also approve your application before a transfer can occur.
