I. <u>Introduction and Summary</u>:

The Statewide Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P & T) Committee is responsible for developing the formulary for the Georgia Department of Corrections (GDC) monitoring drug usage and compliance with pharmacy practice.

II. Authority:

A. NCCHC 2018 Adult Standard: P-D-01; and

B. ACA Standard: 5-ACI-6A-43.

III. Definitions:

- A. **Formulary** A written list of the medications authorized for use in GDC.
- B. **Over-the-Counter Medications (OTC)** Medications that do not require an order from a licensed prescriber. These drugs are approved by the Food & Drug Administration (FDA) for sale without a prescription.
