## 5000.3C Tuition, Standard Fees, Housing, and Dining Fees Procedure

There are three categories of tuition and fees that are established and assessed: tuition, standard fees, and housing and dining fees. Current rates are available on the Gillette Community College District website.

## **Tuition Fees**

- Tuition is established by the Wyoming Community College Commission.
- Tuition is charged per credit.
- Tuition is refundable according to the Refund Procedure (5000.3F).

## **Standard Fees**

- Standard Fees are established and periodically revised by the District administration.
- The following fees are assessed per credit hour as applicable:
  - Student
  - Institutional
  - Facility/Technology
  - o Course
  - Online Course
  - o Overload
- The following fees are flat fees and are assessed based on usage, applicable enrollment or specific situation:
  - o Program
  - o Course
  - o Usage
  - o Workforce Development and Community Service
  - o Conferencing/Agri-Park
  - Placement or Industry Testing
  - Late
  - Non-Sufficient Funds
  - Stop Payment
  - o Miscellaneous
  - Unreturned equipment or uniforms
  - o Library Fine
