Oath of Office

102.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that oaths, when appropriate, are administered to department members.

102.2 POLICY

It is the policy of the Glynn County Police Department that all sworn members of the Department affirm the oath of their office as an expression of commitment to the constitutional rights of those served by the Department and the dedication of its sworn members to their duties.

102.3 OATH OF OFFICE

The oath of office shall be administered by the Judge of the Probate Court of Glynn County or higher to each officer hired by the Glynn County Police Department prior to assuming sworn status. Each officer shall be required to take and subsequently abide by the oath of office and to sign a written copy of the oath. The Chief of Police or his designated representative shall witness and date the written copy.
