

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR SPECIAL OPERATIONS PERSONNEL

1. **REGULATIONS:** These regulations are in addition to the basic requirements for all personnel.
2. **UNIFORM**
 - A. **COMMON REQUIREMENTS:** These requirements are common to all Special Operations Division personnel.
 1. All units are authorized to wear unit pins as approved by the Chief of Police. These are to be worn above the name plate as outlined in the Class A Duty Uniform.
 2. All officers assigned to specialized units will be required to maintain a Class A Duty Uniform, even though it may not be their normal duty uniform.
 - B. **TRAFFIC SERVICES UNIT:** Traffic Services Unit Officers will wear the Class A Duty Uniform.
 - C. **MOTOR CARRIER:** Motor Carrier Safety Unit (MCSU) Officers will wear the black fatigue uniform when performing MCSU functions. They may also wear the approved work jacket, cloth breast shield, and the tactical nylon belt with accessories.
 - D. **SWAT AND CANINE:** SWAT Team and Canine Unit Officers will wear the Fatigue Uniform for normal duty. The unit supervisors may designate other clothing to be worn during training.
 1. SWAT and Canine members will wear a ball cap identical in color to their duty uniform embroidered with SWAT. or Canine.
 2. In the event of a SWAT call-out, the unit supervisors may designate other clothing to be worn. Bright jewelry, pins, shields, name plates or other reflective objects will not be worn during tactical operations.
 3. The gun belt worn during call-outs and as otherwise designated will be the approved black tactical nylon belt and accessories.
 - E. **BOMB SQUAD:** The primary duty uniform of the Bomb Technician is determined by current standards adopted by the FBI and subject to seasonal changes.
 - F. **SAFETY PATROL SERVICES PERSONNEL:** The Class A Duty uniform will be worn with the following exceptions:

1. The approved shirt is light blue. Supervisors' shirts will have gold sergeant stripes. Other insignia will be identical to that of the Class A Duty Uniform.
2. Approved ball caps may be worn.
3. Approved white or high visibility gloves will be worn while directing traffic.
4. Safety Patrol Services Personnel do not wear an accessory belt.
