#### **Documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.**

US Passport or US Passport Card  
Permanent Resident Card or Alien  
Registration Receipt Card (Form  
I-551)  
Foreign Passport that contains a  
temporary I-551 stamp or  
temporary I-551 printed notation  
machine readable immigrant visa  
Employment Authorization Docu-  
ment that contains a photograph  
(Form I-766)  
For a non-immigrant individual au-  
thorized to work for a specific em-  
ployer because of their status:  
A. Foreign passport; and  
B. Form I-94 or Form I-94A that has  
the following:  
1. The same name as the passport;  
and  
2. An endorsement of the individu-  
al's non-immigrant status as long  
as that period of endorsement has  
not yet expired and the proposed  
employment is not in conflict with  
any restrictions or limitations or  
limitations identified on the form.  
Passport from the Federated States  
of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic  
of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with  
Form I-94 or Form I-94A indicating  
non immigrant admission under the  
Compact of Free Association  
Between the United States and the  
FSM or RMI

#### **Documents that establish identity.**

Driver's license or ID card issued  
by a State or outlying possession  
of the United States provided it  
contains a photograph or infor-

and address  
ID card issued by federal, state or  
local government agencies or enti-  
ties, provided it contains a photo-  
graph or information such as  
name, date of birth, gender,  
height, eye color, and address  
School ID card with a photograph  
Voter's registration card  
U.S. Military card or draft card  
Military dependent's ID card  
U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mari-  
ner Card  
Native American tribal document  
Driver's license issued by a Canadi-  
an government authority

#### **For persons under age 18 who are unable to present a document listed above:**

School record or report card  
Clinic, doctor or hospital record  
Day-care or nursery school record

Original or certified copy of  
birth certificate issued by a  
State, County, Municipal  
Authority, or Territory of the  
United States bearing an  
official seal  
Native American Tribal  
Document  
U.S. Citizens ID Card (Form  
I-197)  
Identification Card for Use of  
Resident Citizen in the United  
States (Form I-179)  
Employment authorization  
document issued by the  
Department of Homeland  
Security
