I. PURPOSE

Establish guidelines for a plan of action to be taken by police employee's arriving on the scene of a major crime.

II. POLICY

Available police employees shall assist at the scene of major crimes. When investigations personnel are unavailable, uniformed officers shall proceed with the investigation.

III. **DEFINTIONS**

A. MAJOR CRIME SCENE – instances that involve death, attempted murder, child molestation, rape, or other sexual offenses against minors.

IV. PROCEDURE

- A. The first police employees arriving at the scene of a major crime shall:
- 1. Proceed with caution in the event the suspects are in the immediate area. Then after securing the scene remain at the scene to assist with or conduct the investigation;
- 2. Determine if medical assistance is required by any victims;
- 3. Protect the scene from intrusion by unauthorized persons;
- 4. Obtain descriptions of any possible suspects and vehicles;
- 5. Obtain names, addresses, and telephone numbers of witnesses;
- 6. Not remove any evidence, taking notes indicating the location and brief description of articles present;;
- 7. As soon as practical, notify the District Investigative Commander (DIC) to request a detective be assigned to investigate;
- 8. Upon the arrival of investigative personnel disseminate any information obtained; and
- 9. If investigations personnel are unavailable, uniformed officers shall proceed with the investigation.
- B. This procedure is to be used in conjunction with all relevant Department regulations, rules, policies, and procedures.
