PURPOSE

This policy ensures that research involving human subjects is conducted in an ethical manner.

POLICY

All research using human subjects conducted at Jacksonville State University or under the aegis of the University, irrespective of funding source, must be reviewed, approved, and monitored by the Institutional Review Board for the Protection of Human Subjects in Research (IRB).
