Series 500: Student Conduct and Expectations

In a productive learning environment, faculty and students work cooperatively, recognize and respect differences, and model the value of character and citizenship. The Board of Trustees expects that Kirkwood students will follow all applicable laws, regulations, and College rules in working toward their educational goals. The Board of Trustees authorizes the President and/or designees to establish and enforce rules of student conduct, including provisions for academic and non-academic conduct. These rules will include procedures for investigating and adjudicating disciplinary complaints and will include the establishment of sanctions.

Conduct rules and procedures are made available to students through the Kirkwood catalog. Students are responsible for being familiar with the information contained in the catalog, including any changes to rules or procedures made by the College and communicated to students.
