Regular SNAP	LaCAP
Citizenship/Alien Status (B-220-SNAP)	The requirements are the same, but eligibility is established through the SDX match. There is no worker action required. (K-210-LaCAP)
Enumeration (B-400-SNAP)	The requirements are the same, but eligibility is established through the SDX match. There is no worker action required. (K-210-LaCAP)
Income (B-600-SNAP)	N/A (K-240-LaCAP)
Residency (B-900-SNAP)	The requirements are the same, but eligibility is established through the SDX match. There is no worker action required. (K-220-LaCAP)
Resources (B-1000)	N/A (K-240-LaCAP)
Work Requirements (B-1400-SNAP)	N/A
Household Determination (C-100-SNAP)	Must be a one-person household. Cannot receive LaCAP if living with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • spouse or children under age 22, or • others with whom meals are purchased and prepared. (K-230-LaCAP)
Ineligible if institutionalized or sanctioned for IPV (C-140-SNAP)	Same (K-210-LaCAP)
Application Processing (C-600-SNAP)	No interviews are required No expedited services No proration of benefits No simultaneous issuance (K-300-LaCAP)
Redeterminations (C-700-SNAP)	Certification periods are 36 months (K-343-LaCAP) Re-Enrollment form is mailed in 34 th month. No interviews are required.
Changes (C-800-SNAP)	There are no change reporting requirements, but action must be taken if a change is reported. If SSA reports through SDX that the individual: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • becomes ineligible for SSI • is no longer in living, arrangement code “A”, • moves out of Louisiana, • becomes institutionalized, or • has died, the case will be automatically closed and automated notice sent, if appropriate. Issuing Benefits (C-900-SNAP)	Benefit amount is based solely upon total shelter costs. There are * 3 ** standard allotments. (K-620-LaCAP)
Louisiana Purchase Automated Benefit Card (C-1010-SNAP and Chapter 3, D-110)	EBT card will be sent the day after the case is pended on LAMI. (K-710-LaCAP)
Verification (C-1100-SNAP)	Verification of shelter expenses should be requested only if questionable. All other verification requirements are met through the SDX match. (K-320-LaCAP)
Documentation (C-1210-SNAP)	Everything is documented on the * case note **. (K-810-LaCAP)
Cooperation (C-1310-SNAP)	(K-910-LaCAP)
Appeal Rights (C-1410-SNAP)	Same (K-1010-LaCAP)
Claims (F-100-SNAP)	Forms 20CD must be completed manually. (K-1220-LaCAP)
