Quality Control (QC) is in the \*Quality Improvement Case Review Unit within the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS). QC conducts federally mandated reviews in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Child Support Enforcement (CSE), and the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP), with state reviews of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program. The purpose of QC for the federally mandated reviews is to determine whether benefits were authorized accurately and payments made properly. QC may conduct slant reviews of the TANF program. TANF reviews are based on past fiscal years audit findings from the Louisiana Legislative Auditor's Office. \*\*
