Resources are assets or possessions which a household can convert to cash to meet needs.

The value of liquid resources is considered when determining eligibility. Examples of liquid resources include cash, bank accounts, and stocks. Refer to B-1040-SNAP for additional information.

The value of non-liquid resources is not considered when determining eligibility. Examples of non-liquid resources include buildings, land, and mineral rights.
