## I. STATEMENT OF POLICY


SNAP eligibility is limited to households whose incomes are determined to meet the income limits in the Income Eligibility Chart. Households having at least one member who is 60 years of age or older, or receives SSI, or Social Security Disability, or Veteran's (rated or paid as total) Disability payments are only required to meet the Maximum Net Monthly Income Eligibility Standard. All other households are required to meet the Maximum Gross and Maximum Net Monthly Income Standards. Broad-Based-Categorically Eligible (BBCE) households are required to meet the Maximum Gross Monthly Income Standard of 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) instead of 130% of the FPL.

The SNAP Income Eligibility Chart is as follows:

A household may have gross and net income which does not exceed the gross and net income limits, but the net income may result in a zero SNAP allotment. These households are not eligible for benefits.

A one and two-person traditional categorically eligible household and a BBCE household that is over the net income limit is eligible to receive the minimum SNAP allotment.

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## II. PROCEDURES

Determine eligibility using the Income Eligibility Chart. After eligibility has been determined, determine the household's SNAP allotment by using the Basis of Issuance Tables (see Chart in [J-311](#)).
