

9-405 ENVIRONMENTAL, HEALTH, AND FIRE SAFETY OF THE HOME

To ensure the safety and well-being of children in care, certified foster and adoptive homes must meet the requirements as stated in CW Form HDU-5; and must be determined to be safe by the Home Development worker assigned to the case in the following areas:

- 1. Interior Environments
- 2. Location of the Home
- 3. Exterior Environment
- 4. Play Area and Equipment
- 5. Water Safety
- 6. General Safety
- 7. Fire Safety
- 8. Sanitation and Health
- 9. Transportation Safely

If a specific safety requirement cannot be met, a policy exception or waiver may be requested pursuant to CW policy 9-410, provided the non-compliance does not pose an unreasonable risk to the child's safety or health.
