Application for CDL Waiver for Farm-Related Service Industries

This waiver may be used by seasonal commercial motor vehicle (CDL) drivers for farm retail outlets and suppliers, agricultural businesses, customer harvesters, and livestock feeders. This waiver allows a seasonal driver to obtain a restricted Class B or Class C CDL license without written or skills testing. The holder of a restricted CDL may operate a commercial motor vehicle only within a 150-mile radius of a place of business or farm being served.

Note: The holder of a Restricted Class B or C CDL issued through this waiver program is not allowed to transport passengers or hazardous materials that require the vehicle to be placarded, with the exception of 1,000 gallons or less of diesel fuel, 3,000 gallons of liquid fertilizers, or any quantity of solid fertilizers.	

Seasonal Period	
You must indicate the seasonal period below, which cannot exceed 210 consecutive days in any 12 month period. You must carry this with your driver's license.

For transport of hazardous materials requiring placarding, restricted CDL holders would be limited to:

- Diesel fuel in quantities of 1,000 gallons or less
- Liquid fertilizers in vehicles with total capacities of 3,000 gallons or less; and
- Solid fertilizers that are not mixed with any organic substances
- No other placarded hazardous materials may be transported by holders of restricted CDLs.

Restricted CDL holders will be fully subject to all CDL disqualification penalties.
