

## LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONS OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Act 1201 (R.S. 10:9-404), relative to Louisiana Commercial Laws passed by the 1995 Legislature, provides that effective January 1, 1996, a termination statement be filed with the Office of Motor Vehicles by a secured party (lienholder) to the effect that he no longer claims a security interest in a titled motor vehicle. This report must be filed with the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of Motor Vehicles, P.O. Box 64886, Baton Rouge, LA 70896-4886, Attention: Title Registration Unit, within one month from the expiration of the five year filing date or within ten days following written demand by debtor who has created a security interest in a titled motor vehicle. A \$5.00 termination filing fee is required for each vehicle listed on this termination statement.
