

Louisiana Department of Public Safety Office of Motor Vehicles Policy 33.00 Updates to Driver's License Masters on Cancelled, Deceased, or Out-of-State Drivers

R.S. 32:1420 Administrative

Objective:

• Master record information for a credential shall indicate if a license has been cancelled, including out-of-state transfers, or if a license holder is deceased. This policy describes instances when a credential is cancelled and the procedures for cancelling a credential.

Definitions:

• Master Record – Database where all the driver information is stored

Eligibility:

• NA

General:

- Deceased Individuals Once a death certificate is issued, information from Louisiana Department of Health will be sent electronically to the Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV), which will automatically update the individual's master record.
- **Out-of-State** Upon issuance of a credential in another state, the individual's master record may be cancelled without notice from Louisiana OMV.¹
