- Vehicle(s) covered

Sales Tax Exemption - I certify that I am a Florida resident stationed outside of Florida on military orders. I have purchased the vehicle described above in <u>another state or country</u> and I am applying to title and register the vehicle in Florida. The vehicle will not be brought into Florida for six (6) months or longer. I understand that if I fraudulently claim this exemption to evade the payment of sales tax, pursuant to F.S. 212.085, I will be liable for payment of the sales tax plus a penalty of 200% of the tax and subject to conviction of a third degree felony. A copy of my <u>military orders</u> is attached.

I certify that my vehicle referenced above will be maintained in the state of ______, where I am stationed on military orders during the time period of ______ thru _____, will not be driven in the state of Florida, except in a transient visitor status.

I hereby attest that I continue to be eligible for a Disabled Veteran, Disabled Veteran Wheelchair or Paralyzed Veterans of America license plate and I am therefore able to renew my existing registration.
