CDL Federal Vision Waiver

The Driver License Office charges a <u>minimum</u> fee of \$6.25 to access your driver license record – this includes all questions, research, and all transactions.

All Florida Commercial Driver License (CDL) applicants must schedule an appointment at <u>taxcollector.com</u> and complete a <u>Driver License Application</u>.

Commercial driver license (CDL) holders are held to a higher standard of vision than other drivers. If you do not meet the minimum Federal vision requirement of **20/40 or better in each eye** with or without best correction (glasses or contacts), you will be restricted to intrastate operation and a <u>2 restriction</u> will be placed on your CDL.

The chart below compares **intrastate** operation (2 restriction) to a regular CDL license without restriction that allows for **interstate** operation.

Interstate Operation Regular CDL License	Intrastate Operation CDL License with 2 Restriction
Authorized to operate a Commercial Motor Vehicle in ALL states	Authorized to operate a Commercial Motor Vehicle ONLY in Florida
Authorized to transport loaded cargo that originated out-of-state	NOT authorized to transport loaded cargo that originated out-of-state
Authorized to transport loaded cargo that is being shipped out-of-state	NOT authorized to transport loaded cargo that is being shipped out-of-state

The only way to have the 2 restriction removed from your CDL is by obtaining a **Federal Vision Waiver** and presenting it to our office with your driver license application. (Fees will be incurred to issue a new license without the 2 restriction.)

Please note that Federal Vision Waivers are only available to those individuals who have held a CDL license for <u>at least 3 years prior to loss of vision</u>.

To obtain a Federal Vision Waiver, you must contact the **FMCSR Office of Bus and Truck Standards at (703) 448-3094** to see if you are <u>eligible to apply</u> and to <u>request an application packet</u>. The application process takes 180 days from receipt of application, regardless if you are approved or not.
