# .01 Purpose

To establish and maintain a process by which the MSP defines the prerequisite training or skills required by troopers seeking an assignment or transfer to a specialized unit.

# .02 Policy

All specialized units, whether a full- or part-time assignment, will establish criteria for the training that is required to perform the job functions and responsibilities of the assignment.

# .03 Definitions

SPECIALIZED TRAINING: training course recognized or approved by the MSP and/or the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commissions (MPCTC).

SPECIALIZED UNIT: unit or assignment not affiliated with the Field Operation Bureau that requires training above what is offered at the Academy or at in-service.

#### .06 Procedures

#### A. Eligibility for Assignment

- 1. Commanders of specialized units may establish requirements that troopers complete certain training prior to being considered for assignment to that unit.
- 2. Unless stated otherwise by a particular specialized unit, a trooper seeking assignment to a specialized unit will:
  - a. successfully complete his probationary period;
  - b. achieve an overall rating of "meets expectations" or "exceeds expectations" during the previous two appraisal periods; and
  - c. not be the subject of a pending administrative investigation involving a category "D" or "E" offense.

### B. Responsibilities

- 1. Commanders of specialized units will establish criteria for assignments to their units and will:
  - a. establish the knowledge, skills, abilities and training requirements that are necessary for personnel seeking reassignment to their specialized unit;<sup>1</sup>
  - b. annually update the entry-level training criteria, to include additions to prerequisite training mandates;
  - c. annually update the criteria for mandated continuing education training needed for troopers to continue effective service within the unit;<sup>2</sup>
  - d. submit the entry-level and continuing-education training standards to the Education & Training Division (ETD) by July 1;
  - e. ensure troopers assigned to their unit have an opportunity to attend mandated continuing education;
  - f. establish parameters for remedial mandated retraining needed for troopers to continue effective service within the specialized unit;<sup>3</sup>
  - g. establish guidelines for the reassignment and/or transfer of troopers who fail to obtain or maintain mandated certification; and
  - h. assist troopers in planning their career paths through formal training courses to improve their knowledge, skills and abilities to serve in specialized units.<sup>4</sup>
- 2. ETD will be the repository for the training requirements and documentation for various specialized units and will:
  - a. post the updated training requirements on the PowerDMS;
  - b. maintain records of personnel who complete specific retraining required for continued service within a specialized unit; and

- c. disseminate information about upcoming training courses and seminars as they relate to satisfying training requirements.
- 3. Employees will:
  - a. obtain the required training to satisfy the criteria for entry into a specialized unit;
  - b. obtain the required retraining to satisfy requirements needed for continued service within the specialized unit;
  - c. successfully complete courses and continuing education as required for assignment in specialized units;
  - d. upon completion of any training, complete a Form 8, Training Received, and submit it with a copy of the diploma or training certificate and final grade to MPCTC for entry into the trooper's permanent training record.<sup>5</sup>
- 4. If a trooper fails to successfully complete the required training after a specific period of time or number of remedial attempts, he may be reassigned or transferred.
- E. Availability
  - 1. Troopers interested in reassignment to a specialized unit will be able to access the prerequisite training requirements on the PowerDMS.
  - 2. Troopers seeking to obtain training to satisfy prerequisite requirements for reassignment to a specialized unit must complete a Form 9, Request for Training, as prescribed in PER 04.05.
