Property valued at less than \$50,000: The seizing agency intends to forfeit and dispose of the above property according to the provisions cited above. A bond may be required\*. The written claim and bond (if required) must be filed at the above address within 20 days after receiving this notice (or the date of the first publication of this notice in the newspaper). Upon receipt of a written claim and bond, a court action will be filed to decide the forfeiture issue in accordance with the law. Failure to file a claim of interest and bond within the 20 days shall cause the listed property to be declared forfeited and disposed of according to law. A written claim of interest for a CSA forfeiture must be made on SCAO form MC311.

\*Forfeitures pursuant to the ITPA may also require a bond of 10% of the value of the seized property, not less than \$250.00 nor greater than \$5,000.00 posted with the written claim, within 20 days of receipt of this notice or publication of this notice in the newspaper. MCL 445.79b

**STOLEN, EMBEZZLED, OR CONVERTED PROPERTY CHAPTER OF THE PENAL CODE (CHOP SHOP)**  
If you or any person claiming an interest in the above described property wish to challenge the seizure and forfeiture of the property or wish to claim an interest in the property, you must file a written claim with the prosecutor's office after receipt of this notice.

**GAMBLING CHAPTER OF THE PENAL CODE OR GAMING CONTROL AND REVENUE ACT**  
If you or any person claiming an interest in the above described property wish to challenge the seizure and forfeiture of the property or wish to claim an interest in the property, you must file a written claim with the prosecutor's office after receipt of this notice.

**REVISED JUDICURE ACT of 1961 (OMNIBUS)**  
If you or any person claiming an interest in the above-described property wish to challenge the seizure and forfeiture of the property or wish to claim an interest in the property, you must file a written claim with the prosecutor's office after receipt of this notice.
