PURPOSE: This Order establishes department policy for meetings subject to the open meetings

act.

14-03-1 POLICY

The department is committed to transparency, accountability, and fostering public participation in decision-making processes. Therefore, it is the policy of this department to adhere to the principles and requirements outlined in the Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.261 et seq. (OMA) to ensure that all meetings subject to the OMA are open and accessible to the public.

14-03-2 OPEN MEETINGS ACT
