PURPOSE: This Order establishes guidelines for referring drivers to the Michigan Department of State for a driver evaluation/reexamination.

06-10-1 POLICY

It is the department's policy for enforcement members to submit a licensed driver for reexamination when there is reason to believe that the person is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle or is afflicted with a mental or physical infirmity, or disability, rendering it unsafe for that person to drive a motor vehicle.

06-10-2 PROCEDURES

- A. Enforcement members who have reason to believe that a driver may be unable to operate a motor vehicle safely due to a mental or physical infirmity, or disability, should refer the driver to the Michigan Department of State, Driver Assessment Section, for reexamination as provided for in MCL 257.320.
 - (1) During contact with drivers, enforcement members should be alert for evidence that may justify re-examination. This may include:
 - a. Mental or physical infirmities
 - b. Disabilities
 - c. Vision deficiencies
 - d. Convulsions or seizures
 - e. Blackout episodes
 - f. Other conditions that may affect driving ability
 - (2) In cases where there is reason to believe a condition exists, the enforcement member shall complete the electronic <u>Request for Driver Evaluation</u>, <u>State of Michigan form</u> <u>eDA-88</u>.
 - a. When it is not practical or accessible to complete the electronic form, the DA-88 may be completed and emailed to <u>MedicalForms@michigan.gov</u>.
