#### .01 Purpose

To define the authority and jurisdiction of the MCP.

#### .02 Policy

MCP will provide law enforcement and security services as established under Maryland Law and at the direction of the Secretary of the Department of General Services (DGS).

#### .03 Authority

MD CODE ANN., STATE FIN. & PROC. § 4-601, § 4-604, § 4-605.

#### .04 Procedures

- A. General Authority of the DGS and MCP
  - 1. The State Finance and Procurement Article of the Maryland Annotated Code give authority and responsibility to DGS.
  - 2. MD CODE ANN., STATE FIN. & PROC. § 4-601 establishes that the Department has jurisdiction over and full police authority for the enforcement of the criminal laws and the parking and motor vehicle laws as to the operation, maintenance, and protection of:
    - a. buildings and grounds that, on June 30, 1984, were administered by the Office of Annapolis Public Buildings and Grounds, and extending to the surrounding area that encompasses 1,000 feet in any direction from the boundary of those buildings and grounds;
    - b. buildings and grounds that, on June 30, 1984, were administered by the Office of Baltimore Public Buildings and Grounds, and extending to the surrounding area that encompasses 1,000 feet in any direction from the boundary of those buildings and grounds;
    - c. multiservice centers designated by law or by the Board of Public Works and extending to the surrounding area that encompasses 1,000 feet in any direction from 11 the boundary of those multiservice centers;
    - d. buildings and grounds that, on June 30, 2019, were administered by the Maryland Department of Labor (MDL), and extending to the surrounding area that encompasses 1,000 feet in any direction from the boundary of those building;
    - e. State-owned or State-leased buildings and grounds and extending to the surrounding area that encompasses 1,000 feet in any direction from the boundary of those buildings and grounds; and
    - f. other public improvements or grounds designated by law or by the Board of Public Works.

- MD CODE ANN., STATE FIN. & PROC. § 4-604 delineates the responsibilities that DGS has for all improvements, grounds, and multiservice centers under its jurisdiction, these responsibilities include:
  - a. protecting persons and property, including dispersing any assemblage that is unlawful, is dangerous, or obstructs free passage;
  - b. preserving and protecting the public peace, health, and safety; and
  - c. controlling pedestrian and vehicular traffic, including establishing speed limits and parking and impoundment regulations for parking garages, surface parking lots, roads, and sidewalks that are owned or leased by the State and that are within the improvements, grounds, and multiservice centers.
- 4. MD CODE ANN., STATE FIN. & PROC. § 4-605 authorizes the Secretary to establish a police and security force, known as the Maryland Capitol Police, to protect people and property on or about improvements, grounds, and multiservice centers under the jurisdiction of the Department, and in the surrounding areas of the buildings and grounds in the State as described in § 4–601.
- B. MCP Areas of Responsibility
  - 1. Although the above legislation gives authority to MCP to enforce the criminal and traffic laws on any State owned or leased property, MCP will provide law enforcement and security services at facilities operated by DGS, or as authorized by the Secretary, DGS.
  - 2. MCP currently patrols and secures only two of the DGS operated District Court and Multi-service Centers, however, when directed, MCP may be called upon to provide law enforcement or security services at other District Court and Multi-service Center locations throughout the State.
  - 3. In July 2019, legislation was enacted which gave MCP responsibility for certain facilities operated by MDL.
