

As a sexual offender or sexual predator, you must register with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) through the Sheriff's Office by providing the following information to the department:

1. Name;
2. Social Security Number;
3. Age;
4. Race;
5. Sex;
6. Date of Birth;
7. Height;
8. Weight;
9. Hair and Eye Color;
10. Photograph;
11. Address of Legal Residence;
12. Address of any current temporary residence, within the state or out of state, including a rural route address and a post office box;
13. Any electronic mail address and any instant message name;
14. Date and place of any employment;
15. Date and place of each conviction;
16. Fingerprints; and
17. A brief description of the crime or crimes committed.

A post office box shall not be provided in lieu of a physical residential address.

If your place of residence is a motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home or manufactured home, you shall also provide written notice of the:

1. Vehicle Identification Number
2. License Tag Number;
3. Registration Number; and
4. A description, including color scheme of the motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, or manufactured home.

If your place of residence is a vessel, live-aboard vessel or houseboat, you shall also provide written notice of the:

1. Hull Identification Number;
2. Manufacturer's Serial Number;
3. Name of the vessel, live-aboard vessel or houseboat;
4. Registration Number; and
5. A description, including color scheme of the vessel, live-aboard vessel or houseboat.

If you are enrolled, employed or carrying a vocation at an institution of higher education in this state, you shall also provide to the department the:

1. Name;
2. Address; and
3. County of each institution, including each campus attended and your enrollment or employment status.

Each change in enrollment or employment status shall be reported, in person, at the Sheriff's Office; or the Department of Corrections, if you are in the custody or control of or under the supervision of the Department of Corrections, within forty-eight (48) hours after any change in status.

You may also need to provide any other information determined necessary by the department, including:

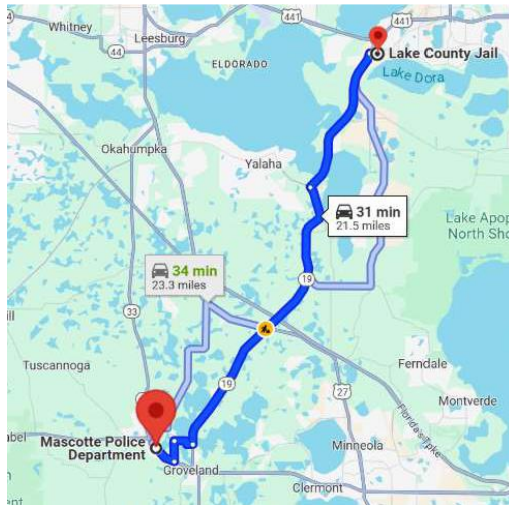
1. Criminal and Corrections Records;
2. Non-Privileged Personnel or Treatment Records; and
3. Evidentiary Genetic Markers when available.

Beginning at the Mascotte Police Department, 529 East Myers Boulevard, Mascotte, Florida, 34753:

1. Head southeast On FL-33S/State Route 50 E/East Myers Boulevard toward Albrook Street;
2. Turn left onto Albrook Street;
3. Turn right at the first cross street on FL-33S/State Route 50 E/East Myers Boulevard (Continue to follow FL-33/ State Route 50 E;
4. Turn left onto Villa City Road;
5. Turn right onto Bible Camp Road;
6. Turn left onto FL-19 N (Continue to follow FL-19 N);

7. Turn right on FL-19;
8. Turn right onto West Main Street, Tavares, Florida;
9. Continue on West Main Street for 0.3 miles;
10. Arrive at the Lake County Jail, 551 West Main Street, Tavares, Florida, 32778.
