Overview:

In 2022, New Castle County police officers generated and responded to 98,981 calls and made 5,340 arrests for a total of 11,829 distinct criminal charges. Force was used in 233 of these incidents.

The chart and graph shown below indicates the number of Response to Resistance reports submitted over the past five years, including 2022, and the year-to-year changes.
