Annual Response to Resistance Report / Assault on Sworn Officer Review 2023

CALEA Standard 4.2.4 & 4.2.5

Overview:

In 2023, New Castle County police officers generated and responded to 99,645 calls and made 4,963 arrests for a total of 11,189 distinct criminal charges. Force was used in 198 of these incidents.

The chart and graph shown below indicates the number of Response to Resistance reports submitted over the past six years, including 2023, and the year-to-year changes.
